Suggestions	Action Taken
More number of sponsored projects	The numbers of sponsored projects have been augmented. Consultancy activities carried out for various industries through "problem box".
More internship is needed.	The efforts are being made to provide more opportunities of internship for the students
Interaction with alumni is needed to know latest trends and recruitment system.	Alumni meets are regularly organized in order to provide opportunity to interact with third and final year students. Departments are advised to conduct more Alumni meet, Guest Lectures.
Campus recruitment training is needed from third year onwards.	In order to provide campus recruitment training the reputed experienced persons from industry and academics are invited. These experienced persons provide the students with campus recruitment training. Training department will organize more training for improving placement.


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3. From Employer

Suggestions	Action Taken
Specialized value addition course are needed in syllabus.	Syllabus is framed by the university, yet some short term certification programs have been included in the curriculum. Skill development team will conduct more specialized value added courses.
Expert lectures of persons from industry will be helpful.	The college is aware of the necessity of guidance of persons from industry and therefore expert persons from industry are regularly invited to guide the students.
University should give more focus on industry exposure and practical application.	Alumni meets/ Guest Lecture are regularly organized in order to provide opportunity to interact with third and final year students.
Campus recruitment training is needed from third year onwards.	The syllabus is framed by the university. The college, however, has planned for industry based projects and made internship mandatory for the students.

Suggestions	Action Taken
Industry based projects and paper presentation by student must be a parameter for assessment of final year students.	Planned to be implemented after COVID situation through various Research Labs.
Students need more scope for selection of elective subjects.	Students can offer any elective subject of his/her choice as per syllabus of the university from next session.
The curriculum is not as per AICTE model Curriculum	The essential courses prescribed by AICTE which are not prescribed by Anna University are offered as Value added courses


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
